

Cold Damages School

The current cold snap caused damage to two radiators in the ill-fated Guigues Separate School on New Year's Day.

However, Aime Arvisais, secretary of the Separate School Board, reports that all will be in readiness for pupils of the school when they trek back to classes on Monday, following the Christmas holidays.

The radiators will be repaired, and facilities will be made ready to accomodate the Grade 5 students who were left without a classroom following an \$80,000 fire at the school on Dec. 21.

Grade 5 children will move from the building's third storey to quarters formerly occupied by youngsters of the kindergarten class on the first floor.

The younger pupils will take their instruction at the Routhier School until repairs are completed at the Guigues School.
