

Guigues School Reopens Today

The new term began this morning with things more or less normal at Guigues Separate School, despite the \$80,000 fire which destroyed or damaged four third-story classrooms Dec. 21.

All but one classroom was in operation this morning and accommodation was made available for its pupils by moving the kindergarten primary to Routhier School on Guigues Street.

Separate School Board officials estimate that the new roof over the damaged classrooms and needed redecorating will be completed by the end of this week. Smoke and water damage will require the whole school to be redecorated but this job will be held over until the summer so that classes will not be disturbed.
